

Camping FAQ Sheet

- ***Are pets allowed at the campground?***
For safety reasons we do not allow pets at our campground
- ***How many tents can you put on site?***
That depends entirely on the size of the site. Tents cannot encroach on another site.
- ***What are in the tent cabins?***
The tent cabins come with 6 cots with pads, a propane lantern and stove, and propane canisters for each. The site has a BBQ/fire pit, picnic table, and sun shade
- ***Can you have more than 6 people in a Tent cabin?***
Maximum occupancy is 6 people per tent cabin and they would not comfortably sleep an additional person
- ***Do you have to have 6 people for a tent cabin?***
If you pay the full rate for a tent cabin in addition to the per person camp fees, this rate reserves your tent cabin for up to 6 people.
- ***Do you have to share a tent cabin if you do not have 6 people?***
You do not have to share the tent if there are fewer than 6 people.
- ***Which campgrounds have tent cabins?***
Two Harbors and Hermit Gulch.
- ***How far in advance can you book a reservation?***
You can book up to 1 year prior to your arrival date.
- ***What do you recommend I bring with me when camping?***
We recommend bringing whatever camping supplies you personally need from; Tents, stoves, lanterns, sleeping bags with pads, though these items can also be rented.
- ***Are there showers at the campground?***
Two Harbors, Little Harbor, and Black Jack all have outdoor cold water showers. Parson's Landing is a Primitive campground and has no running water.
- ***Do you have equipment rentals?***
Yes. The rangers keep a supply of 4 man tents, Sleeping bags & pads, 2 burner propane stoves, and propane lanterns.

- *How big are the lockers?*
The locker sizes slightly vary, but the approx. size is 1 ft wide by 2 ½ ft deep.
- *How far is it from Two Harbors campground to the village?*
Approx. ¼ mile along a footpath.
- *Can you have open fires?*
Campfires are allowed in the designated fire rings only. Each campsite has a fire ring. There are 2 fire rings in the Two Harbors village as well.
- *Do the boat-in sites have facilities?*
Boat in sites do not have facilities. Campers must boat in and boat out everything including toilets.
- *Are there moorings at Little Harbor?*
There are no moorings at little Harbor, though boaters can anchor.
- *Can you visit the campgrounds and not stay the night?*
You cannot use any of the sites for day use except for Shark Harbor.
- *Can you stay in a group campsite with less than 20 people?*
Yes if it is available and if your group is under 10 people you must pay for a minimum of 10 people.
- *Are there rangers at the campgrounds?*
In the off season (fall, winter, spring) there are 2-3 rangers to service Two Harbors, Little Harbor, Parson's Landing, and Black Jack campgrounds. During the summer season there are live-in rangers at Two Harbors and Little Harbor campgrounds.
- *Can you drink alcohol at the campgrounds?*
Only if you are 21 or older!
- *What can you bring on the Safari Bus?*
Your camping and personal gear. The Two Harbors bus can accommodate a limited number of bikes. No Pets allowed on the buses.
- *Is the Safari Bus a tour?*
No. It is transportation between Two Harbors and Avalon, It stops at Little Harbor. There is a bus change at the airport, then a stop at Black Jack before going on to Avalon.
- *Is there electricity at the campgrounds?*
None of the campgrounds have electricity
