



Definition: Zip lines are high cable traverses designed to enable users to propel by gravity from the top to the bottom of an incline using safety harnesses and pulleys suspended on the cable.

Catalina Zip Line Eco Tour FACTS:

- Tour takes approximately 2 hours including orientation/instruction
- Tours run in groups of no more than 12 people
- Advance reservation are recommended
- Price is \$89 per person plus taxes and fees (\$92.50 total)
- Tour begins and ends at Descanso Beach at the zip line tour center (parking lot)
- Participants need to arrive at least 10 minutes prior to scheduled tour time
- Participant weight is limited to no more than 245 pounds (All will be weighed onsite)
- Additional restrictions apply for participants under 100 pounds
- Long shorts or pants and flat, closed-toe shoes are required
- Long hair must be secured with rubber band or similar accessory
- Participants are required to hike short distances, climb stairs & ramps and need to be of average mobility and strength and in reasonably good health
- Participants will be shuttled up to the first platform near the gate to the interior
- The tour consists of 5 total 'zips' or 'runs' totaling 3,671 linear feet
- Course Leg #1 is 501 feet long
- Course Leg #2 is the longest zip at 1,045 feet
- Course Leg #3 is 702' Course Leg #4 is 892' Course Leg #5 is 531'
- Each course leg ends at a unique platform or 'station' with interpretive signage highlighting Catalina Island and its flora, fauna and history
- Maximum heights reach 300 feet above Descanso Canyon floor
- Elevations vary from 500ft above sea level at station 1 to 60ft above sea level at station 6
- Canopy Tours of New Hampshire designed the zip line
- All zip line structures are engineered with a safety factor of 5 times
- All connections are double redundancy (double 1/2" Galvanized steel aircraft cables, double pulleys on the trolley, double harness connections to the trolley)
- Discovery Tours (Santa Catalina Island Company) operate the tours daily
