



Important Info Regarding the Catalina Zipline Eco Tour:

- Tour lasts approximately 2 hours, including orientation/instruction
- Tours run in groups of no more than 10 participants
- Advance reservation is recommended
- Price is \$99 per person plus taxes and fees (\$103 total)
- Tour begins and ends at the Descanso Beach Zipline tour center
- Participants need to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to scheduled tour time
- Participant weight may not exceed 245 pounds (All will be weighed onsite during check-in process)
- Participants 5-9 years old must ride tandem with accompanying guardian at least 18 years of age
- Participants at least 10 years of age may ride solo. However, those weighing less than 90 lbs may be asked to ride tandem with another participant across certain zip lines
- Combined weight of tandem riders may not exceed 245 lbs
- For safety reasons, participants must wear sturdy, securable, closed toed shoes. Sneakers or tennis shoes are most appropriate. Inappropriate foot wear such as flats, sandals, water socks, water shoes, Crocks, Toms or Vibrams will not be allowed
- Long hair must be secured with rubber band or similar accessory
- Long shorts or pants are required
- Participants are required to hike short distances, descend stairs, need to be of average mobility and strength and in reasonably good health
- Because of the potential health and safety risk to the baby, pregnant guests will not be allowed to zip



Other Catalina Zipline Eco Tour Facts:

- Zip lines are high cable traverses designed to enable users to propel by gravity from the top to the bottom of an incline using safety harnesses and pulleys suspended on the cable
- Participants will be shuttled up to the first platform near the gate to the island's interior
- The tour consists of 5 total 'zips' or 'runs' totaling 3,671 linear feet
- Zip line #1 is 501 ft long. Zip line #2 is the longest zip at 1,045 ft long. Zip line #3 is 702 ft long. Zip line #4 is 892 ft long. Zip line #5 is 531 ft long.
- Maximum heights reach 300 feet above Descanso Canyon floor
- Each course leg ends at a unique platform or 'station' with interpretive signage highlighting Catalina Island and its flora, fauna and history
- Elevation varies from 500 ft above sea level at station 1 to 60ft above sea level at station 6
- All connections are double redundancy (double 1/2" Galvanized steel aircraft cables, double pulleys on the trolley, double harness connections to the trolley)
- Canopy Tours of New Hampshire designed the zip lines
- Discovery Tours (Santa Catalina Island Company) operate the tours daily
